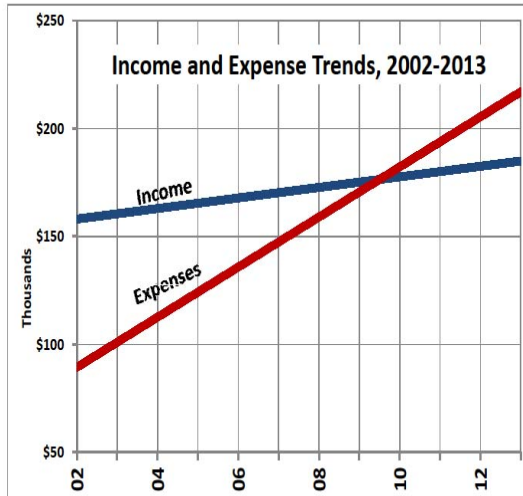

Why Measure M?



- Our fire trucks need to be upgraded in order to continue to serve our district.
- An increase in revenue will allow us to upgrade our life-saving equipment to serve you better.
- It ensures that existing fire stations stay open and that all District homes and parcels will remain insurable.



In 2013 the Albion Little River Fire Department . . .

Responded to **14** fires involving structures and vegetation.

Responded to **8** hazardous materials events.

Responded to **167** emergency medical situations, including rescues of visitors and residents.



Our current parcel assessment has not increased since 2002. Without Measure M the fire department will be unable to maintain our current level of service, forcing us to make painful cuts that will impact our ability to provide district residents with the level of safety you deserve.

It's a Bargain!

Your firefighters are all volunteers. They donate hundreds of hours each year for your protection.

San Francisco spends \$230,000 annually per firefighter. This is more than the entire annual budget of the Albion Little River Fire Protection District. It costs over \$7000 to equip each of our 30 volunteers to meet state mandates.
