- Call to order and determination of a quorum: at 7:29; attending were Ahrens, Taeger, Shock, plus Chief Seeler, Carolyn Latkin, firefighters Josh Latkin, Stacy Weil-Dye, _____, visitors Rick McDonald, Scott ____, Laura Vogelgesang, and William Huff.
- 2. Secretary's Report: Thorpe and Tucker have resigned.
- 3. Election of new officers: Shock was chosen Chairman; Taeger was chosen Treasurer.
- 4. Call for replacements for members of the Board who have resigned: the two positions will be posted and an article will be sent to *The Mendocino Beacon*, inviting prospective members to a Special Meeting on Monday, 11 December.
- 5. Treasurer's Report: the Treasurer's Report was handed out.
- 6. Items for consideration:
 - **6E)** Review of nominees for Chief: the single nominee for Chief, Oliver Seeler, was accepted by the Board.
 - **6G) Tutorial on Long Range Plan implementation:** Chief Seeler requested that the Board get involved in updating the Long Range Plan.
 - **6H) Tactical radios for the firefighters:** the radios have been purchased, and they will be distributed shortly. The Board agreed to pay one-half of the costs.
- 7. Public communication to the Board, opportunity for public comment with respect to matters whether or not on the agenda:
 - A) Visitor Rick McDonald expressed his personal concern that the Board is unable to do its function of providing emergency services during the tenure of Chief Seeler.
 - B) Visitor Laura Vogelgesang expressed concern over the website being out of date.
- 8. Land, buildings and equipment:
 - A) Chief Seeler restated the need to move the Navarro Ridge repeater before January.
- B) The Board requested a one-page map of the Department's area of concern, also showing the location of the vatious stations.
- 9. Fund raising, gifts, and service fees:

- B) Due to a change in the Mutual Aid Agreement with CDF, a new salary fee schedule needs to be written and passed by th Board, in order to collect fees for mutual aid.
